## **Inauguration Conference**

EXCELEM 2.0 Inauguration Conference was held in Aikaterini Laskaridis Foundation on March 7, 2025 bringing together students, researchers, and stakeholders. This was the official launch of the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence "EXCELEM 2.0", a project dedicated to the establishment of a pivotal hub of EU Studies to promote EU Teaching and Research, focusing in the Eastern Mediterranean, through joint transnational activities reinforcing the research community on EU issues.

With the enthusiastic participation of students, academics, researchers and policymakers, the conference sparked rich discussions on issues related to the EU and Eastern Mediterranean, energy, investments, new technologies and security.

#### **Highlights**

#### **Openning Session:**

Prof. Foteini Asderaki, Prof. Guy Ben-Porat and Dr. Hila Zahavi introduced the vision and mission of EXCELEM 2.0, emphasizing new opportunities for academic cooperation and student engagement.

Prof. Aristotle Tziampiris offered a compelling welcome, framing the Centre's role in shaping critical discourse on international and European studies.

#### Session I: EU and Eastern Mediterranean





#### **EXCELEM 2.0 Website**
